Please be kind and sit (with your family) at the ends of the pews so that others may share the pew and still keep 6 feet apart.
	All bibles and other materials have temporarily been removed from the pews. Please bring your own bible if you would like to follow along.
	Due to the airborne nature of the virus, congregational singing is not allowed at this time. Music will still be performed.
S	One location will be designated for tithing at the entrance to the sanctuary. Especially in these times of need, this is more important then ever.
	Communion will be served again, but now using "fellowship cups". These are individual cups that you are welcome to take upon entry. Please carry this garbage out with you after service to throw away in the narthex. It's a modified service but not a modified message.
